Shoot Length: Half Day (first half of day only)

## **ROLES**

- 1 Male
- 1 Female

**RATE:** \$350 per person

**SHOOT DAY:** Half day (first half of the day only)

## **ROLE DESCRIPTION**

We are casting a couple seated at a luxury restaurant on a date. Their interaction anchors the commercial emotionally and visually before the story escalates into fantasy.

The male orders a high-alcohol wine that sparks the chaos.

## **LOOK & VIBE**

**Age Range:** Early 30s – Mid 40s

### **MALE**

- Semi-rugged, masculine energy
- “Looks like he drinks whiskey”
- Charismatic, grounded, confident

### **FEMALE**

- Stylish, elegant, modern
- Natural chemistry with partner
- Comfortable with close-ups and reaction shots

## **NOTES**

- Must feel like a real couple (real couples encouraged, but not required)
- Subtle acting with strong facial reactions

- Minimal dialogue, reaction-driven performance
- Luxury dining wardrobe encouraged (neutral, elevated)

## **SELF-TAPE INSTRUCTIONS**

### **SLATE**

Please state your name, height, and age. Briefly tell us about a memorable date night or night out you've enjoyed. Then clearly show both sides of your hands to camera.

### **ACTION**

You are on a date at an upscale restaurant. You're relaxed, confident, and fully present.

## **MALE SELF-TAPE**

### **PART 1 — DATE ENERGY**

Begin seated, as if across from your date at a table. Deliver the following line naturally and casually:

"Yeah — we'll take a bottle of the high-alcohol wine, please."

Hold for a brief moment. Your energy should feel effortless and grounded.

### **PART 2 — THE MOMENT**

Something unexpected catches your attention just off to the side — the wine glass in front of you subtly moves. Without dialogue, register surprise, let curiosity take over, and stay calm and intrigued. You're interested... not intimidated.

### **PART 3 — THE SIP**

You decide to lean into it. Without dialogue, take a small sip of your drink, let the flavor land, and react with quiet confidence and approval. End with an expression that suggests: "That's bold... I like it."

## **FEMALE SELF-TAPE**

### **PART 1 — DATE ENERGY**

Begin seated, as if listening to your date speak. React naturally as he orders a bold, high-alcohol wine. Your energy should feel warm, curious, and slightly amused.

### **PART 2 — THE MOMENT**

Something unexpected happens — the wine glass in front of you subtly moves off to the side. Without dialogue, notice it, let intrigue replace surprise, and stay calm and present.

### **PART 3 — THE SIP**

You decide to go for it. Without dialogue, take a small sip of your drink, let the taste register, and react with intrigue and approval. End with a look or smile that suggests: "That's interesting... I'm into it."

## **TAKES**

Please send 2–3 versions, each 20–30 seconds max.

Take 1: Subtle, understated, natural

Take 2: Clearer confidence and intrigue

Take 3 (optional): Make it your own

Avoid comedy or exaggeration. Keep it believable and controlled.

### **SELF-TAPE NOTES**

iPhone self-tapes are totally fine. Use a clean, neutral background with natural lighting if possible. No costumes or props needed. Focus on presence, ease, and authentic reactions.
